

## Program

- Associate Degree in General Studies by the end of students' senior year in high school
- Tuition FREE college coursework
- Must complete Trigonometry and Spanish III by the end of 10<sup>th</sup> grade (recommended to also take Personal Finance in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade)
- Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher

#### Remember

- Check graduation requirements
- Check verified credits (passed SOLs)
- Choose 8 classes and 3 alternates alternates are important!
- Complete any necessary course applications/auditions
- Make sure you meet course pre-requisites before signing up
- Schedules will go live in PowerSchool portals in July
- Think of college/job requirements
- Complete worksheet and use to complete online course selection
  - DEADLINE: All course requests must be complete and submitted by Friday, March 3rd.
