- Must complete Trigonometry and Spanish III by the end of \(10^{\text {th }}\) grade (recommended to also take Personal Finance in the \(10^{\text {th }}\) grade)
- Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher

\section*{Remember}
- Check graduation requirements
- Check verified credits (passed SOLs)
- Choose 8 classes and 3 alternates - alternates are important!
- Complete any necessary course applications/auditions
- Make sure you meet course pre-requisites before signing up
- Schedules will go live in PowerSchool portals in July
- Think of college/job requirements
- Complete worksheet and use to complete online course selection
- DEADLINE: All course requests must be complete and submitted by Friday, March 3rd.
